Board of Directors Positions Available

Meets once a month , 9-10 times per year, and ensures proper oversight of the Club to facilitate consistent progress toward its mission.

Registrar – Sits on the executive of the board, works with the technical director to ensure that all athletes are registered in the RAMP system, confirms payments are up to date for the Treasurer’s reports, ensures athlete rosters are accurate and submitted by deadline for tournaments and events, and coordinates the registration of volunteers.

Marketing, Communications & Recruitment Coordinator – sits on the board of directors and works with a committee (to be established) to ensure the website has all applicable and current information, works with technical director to ensure all social media is consistent and updated. Works on marketing the sport of Water Polo with a goal of increasing awareness and participation in the sport and a desire to increase female participation in our club.

Competitive Programs Coordinator – sits on the board of directors and works with the technical director to ensure all travel is coordinated and provides safe and effective experiences for all athletes. The Coordinator is the liaison between the technical director and team chaperones. The Coordinator is responsible for enlisting team managers and working to increase opportunities for athletes within the competitive program to succeed and grow.

Fit For Life Programs Coordinator – sits on the board of directors and works to ensure that athletes in the recreational programs have the opportunities to learn and grow in the sport. The Coordinator will work with other members to support growth in this section of our programming through partnerships and community programming.

Grassroots Coordinator - sits on the board of directors and works with other volunteers to support the overall growth and interest in the sport of Water Polo. This Coordinator will support the technical director in growing the sport in new areas of the city and the province. This coordinator will work to strengthen relationships with MWPA and WPC.

Committees

Time commitment dependent on the nature of the work and the amount of time you have to give!

Marketing, Communications & Recruitment:

- work collaboratively with members to develop recruitment strategies and communication products to support the the club in achieving its goals and aspirations.

Merchandise & Fundraising :

- work collaboratively with members to maintain and research merchandise opportunities for athletes, families and spectators, and to support fundraising activities that benefit both the club and individual athletes.

OTHER: Team Managers (1 per competitive age team)

– These individuals will be responsible for working with the head coaches, Competitive Programs Coordinator and chaperones to ensure that teams are well prepared for competitions and travel.
